Pastor Pat shared Congregational and Community Care Ministry's (CCCM) discussion on the church being "friendly" v. "welcoming;" input was invited.

The Council discussed a proposal received from the Speight family to run a food pantry at OHUMC on two Saturdays a month. After extensive discussion, the Council felt it needed more information before making a decision.
