### CHURCH COUNCIL NOTES - November 17th

<u>Trustees:</u> \*Elevator repairs in progress; water source which caused problem being investigated. \*Walkthrough of parsonage completed; repair list generated. \*7<sup>th</sup> Day Adventist Church has painted exterior windows and will paint Sanctuary soon. \*Repairs (funding not currently available): HVAC in office, heat convector east stairwell, replace kitchen vent system.

Finance: \* End of year finances: a small surplus is expected, not the surplus of \$5,000 budgeted. \*Loan payments continuing. \*Approximately \$30K has been received for the elevator repair. \*2020 budget was approved with projected \$5000 deficit due to decreases in giving, hall rentals and fundraising. Still needed: Finance Chair and Church Treasurer. If a person is not found for the Treasurer's position, the Church may need to pay for those services.

<u>UMM:</u> Looking for ways to be involved in community. Attended UMM Conference.

<u>UMW:</u> Several interactions with Conference UMW. Christmas luncheon Dec. 7<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Worship:</u> The Worship Commission will now be the Worship Design Team. Anyone is welcome to be a part. Team will meet quarterly; next meeting, Sun., Jan. 12, 2020 following worship.

<u>Communications:</u> Steve will conduct a Facebook campaign to promote the *Messiah*. A note will be added to the webpage to advertise that we have space available for parties, functions, etc.

<u>Missions:</u> \*The school supplies will be delivered with the Thanksgiving baskets on Nov. 25<sup>th</sup>. \*Reverse Advent food drive will begin December 1<sup>st</sup> to supplement Oxon Hill Pantry and the Bread Ministry. <u>Pastor:</u> \*A team will be formed to re-establish a youth ministry program at Oxon Hill (motion and approval). \*VBS will be a collaborative project with St. Paul's.

Other Business: \*Guidelines for the Walter Hampton Scholarship fund were discussed and approved. \*Past members of the fundraising committee will be approached by Finance to determine their status. Council minutes are available upon request.
