CHURCH COUNCIL NOTES - February 16th

Council Chair Vivian Sayeh-Weeks opened the meeting by introducing and welcoming Dr. Johnsie Cogman, OHUMC's Interim Pastor and District Superintendent. In the interest of time, Vivian requested brevity from reportees because there were several important matters that needed to be addressed. Trustees: *Pending Finance and Council approval of estimates, possible renovation of the bathrooms and other repairs scheduled for the parsonage. *Investigating the nonfunctioning office AC system. *Cleaning supplies provided by the church are the only ones to be used. *Important to fill out green form for all meetings. Finance: * End of year finances: surplus of \$13K. *Loan payments continuing. *Plans have been devised to temporarily cover the Treasurer's positon. The Disciple does not require that we have a Chair of Finance so that position may remain temporarily vacant. *An external audit, standard procedure with a change in Pastor, will be performed. *Changes to the budget structure were tabled.

UMM and UMW: Both were in service to Warm Nights **UMW** will continue serving Coffee Hour for the 1st Sunday of each month. Council is seeking families and other groups to host additional Sundays - does not have to be regular - one-time host or occasionally is great! A calendar will be established. Worship: *Worship Design Team met 2/17. *In honor of Women's History month, all speakers for March will be women of different backgrounds/ nationalities. The plan is to make the Worship experience an experience, more than just tradition. Communications: Steve will continue Facebook campaigns. The calendar is available on the website and is updated regularly. Missions: *Warm Nights expenses: \$726 for regular supplies; \$340 additional spent to meet client needs: socks, underwear, etc. **Membership** Total members 181: 14 new members received; 6 members removed (charge conference -5; death - 1). Pastor: *Endorses re-establishing a youth ministry program at Oxon Hill. Planning is underway. Next meeting: Sunday, April 19th. Minutes available on request.
