CHURCH COUNCIL NOTES - June 7, 2020

Council Chair Vivian Sayeh-Weeks opened the 3rd meeting of the Church Council for 2020 with brief remarks and an introduction of our new pastor, Mija Cho. Trustees: Completing work at parsonage with Pastor Cho scheduled to move in on June 17th. 7th Day Adventist Church zooming. Reading program cancelled. HVAC needed for office area Staff Parish: Clergy apportionment not paid because we did not have a pastor. Will resume with Pastor Cho. Position of Administrative Assistant (office) has been re-established. **Finance:** Vito has moved to the Treasurer position: Julie Fernandez continues as Financial Secretary. As it is not required by the *Discipline* there will currently be no Finance Chair for now. VBS: not at this time; all conference camps have been cancelled. Missions: Will reach out to Warm Nights to see if we can support in some way. Warm Nights is currently using a motel facility. Bread Ministry: Currently distributing 100 bags each Tuesday. Some food has been purchased; rest coming from grocery stores, donations and other food ministries (sharing when there is surplus). Volunteers welcome. See page 1 UMM: Volunteer at the OH library, Tuesdays 4-6 pm, offering homework help and reading practice for grades 1-6. Also support the English Convention Club for non-English speaking parents. Communications: YouTube channel up and running. Different people handling different social media. Trying to do as much as possible. One Call Now: call, text, Zoom, Free Conference Call needed a license to upload to YouTube. Additional equipment will be needed if we continue to stream once we are back in the building. Fundraising: Will need to refund \$1900 because Lancaster trip March 27th was cancelled. Next meeting: Sun., Aug 16th after worship. A copy of the minutes is available upon request.

Outdoor Worship Services Guidelines Sunday, July 26, 2020, 9:30 AM

The service will be held outside of the entrance to the Fellowship Hall, in the large parking lot. We will be using both a public address system and broadcasting via FM 90.5 radio. The service will also be broadcast on Zoom and on the church's Facebook page.

For those coming in person, there are two options for attending the service:

Drive-ins will be asked to park in designed areas and remain in their vehicles. You will be able to use your vehicle's radio to listen to the service, via your FM radio.

Those sitting outside their vehicle are asked to bring a lawn chair and sit in the designated area. Family members from the same household can sit together. For your safety, we ask that you maintain social distancing- six feet and wear a mask.

Access to the church will be restricted to using the restrooms located on the ground level. Enter via the elevator foyer and take the elevator to the Fellowship Hall level. We ask that you do not enter the Social Hall or any other area of the church.

Hand sanitizer stations will be available at the church entrances and at designated locations in the church.

If possible, **please bring a contribution for the Bread Ministry**: box of pasta or box of cereal, jar of peanut butter or 2 cans of vegetables. There will be a grocery cart by back door to church. Please wear a mask and observe social distancing when placing in cart.
